

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capability. Hook type blade carriages have been consistent.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is around 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold loads as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
